# CSI EU: A way towards social responsibility for SMEs

## ISO 26000

In 2010 the International Organization for Standardization (ISO) published the ISO 26000 guidance on Social Responsibility. ISO 26000 is a guidance which clarifies what social responsibility is, and thereby provides all types of organisations with assistance in relation to translate principles into effective actions and shares best practices in relation to social responsibility.

## CSI EU Learning Portal

Based on ISO 26000, a web based learning portal has been developed, to provide assistance for companies in adopting the principles of Social Responsibility. The general objective of the portal is to improve the quality, efficiency and effectiveness of vocational education and training in Europe, thereby improving global competitiveness of the European corporate sector. The training and web based learning portal will enable the corporate management to continually assess and improve their performance towards sustainable development.

## Using the Learning Portal

The learning portal is intended for small and medium sized enterprises, but other actors will also find it useful. Users will find elements of training and consultancy, and the learning portal is developed as an open source platform, which is accessible for everybody. The training material is a mix of "explaining" elements of ISO 26000 (for example the fundamental principles and core subjects) and "how to" tools – among the many issues are:

- ★ how to review the existing SR effort
- ★ a number of questions for the SME to consider when elaborating an SR profile
- ★ how to map and engage with stakeholders
- ★ how to monitor and report on SR performance
